

Answer the following questions

1. How do plants make their food?

Ans Plants make their own food by using water, salt, soil and sunlight.

2. Why are some plants not able to make their own food?

Ans Some plants are not able to make their own food as the soil they grow on may not be good enough or they may not get enough sunshine.

3. What kind of animals do plants eat?

Ans Plants can only eat small insects and flies.

4. Why do butterflies and other insects get attracted to the sundew plant?

Ans The leaves of sundew plants have sticky glue on them which appears like shiny beads. This attracts insects and butterflies to them.

5. Why do flies go to Venus Flytrap?

Ans Flies go to Venus flytrap because its leaves are sweet smelling.



6. How are insects digested by plants?

Ans When insects sit on the leaf of a carnivorous plant, it closes and traps them inside. A juice flows out from the leaf that digests them.
